Durable Medical Equipment How to Guide

Our Registered Nurses are referred to as Health coaches and provide free and confidential case management.

Durable Medical Equipment (DME) and Supplies Process:

DME is equipment that can typically withstand repeated use and is used for a medical reason. Some examples include:

- Diabetic Supplies (Continuous Glucose Monitoring Meters/ Finger Stick Meters & Lancets)
- Sling/Brace/Boot to support a broken limb
- C-Pap Machine & Equipment (Sleep Apnea Machine)
- Orthotics
- Breast Pumps

Note: Preferred DME Supplier is Edgepark

- Initially work with your provider to determine needed DME/supplies
- Provider/member calls Level Care support to verify In Network providers, benefits, and coverage.
- Provider coordinates with DME suppliers to provide needed documentation to get equipment to the member.
- DME suppliers work with IA to ensure processes/medical policies are followed to obtain medically necessary equipment.
